



- Support sustainable competitiveness of economic sectors contributing to the viability of rural areas
- Improve infrastructure and services (clean mobility, incentivise decarbonised electricity structure for rural communities)







Smart villages can be supported under Cooperation intervention, LEADER, Investments under the CAP.

In total, **20 MSs** (Austria, Belgium-Flanders, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Finland, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Luxembourg, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Spain/Extremadura, Sweden, Slovenia) plan to support smart village initiatives. So far, based on the target of 10 MSs, there will be a **minimum of 1073 smart village strategies or projects.**

- 5 MSs have planned to support smart village strategies and projects under cooperation intervention
- 20 MSs have planned to support smart villages through LEADER
- 3 MSs have planned to support infrastructure investments related to smart-village strategies
